

Croton (Dove Weed)



Drought tolerant native that is a favorite of dove, quail, and other birds. An annual that reseeds vigorously. Croton is best established when planted in the cooler months (Dec.— Feb.), but successful stands have been made with spring plantings. Many people disc strips in fields to increase croton as a wildlife food source. The suggested planting rate is 3-5 pounds per acre.
